Role of the winner

The primary focus for the winner of the competition is to promote the Regatta Ambassador Quest for the following year and to help implement any ideas that may increase numbers to the Royal Hobart Regatta. This will include:

- Promoting the Regatta Ambassador Quest through a number of avenues (radio, newspaper, fliers, media). This gives great opportunities for widening your public profile and communication skills
- Sponsorship/Promotion: Securing existing and new sponsors of the Ambassador Quest Competition, who provide prizes for the First, Second and Third place winners.
- Sashes/Medals/Trophy: Organise the trophy for the winner, medals for all entrants and sashes for the first, second & third place winners of the Ambassador Quest and for the Junior Boy/Girl Pageant.
- Assisting with organisation of the following year's quest including entry forms, contact list and liaison with judges.
- 2012 Regatta Day: The previous year's winner assists on the day either as a judge of the competition &/or to be the main point of contact for all entrants on the day.
- The previous year's winner escorts entrants on the Police Launch from Watermans Dock to the Regatta Ground and provides the winner with information about their role during the next year.

Judging

There are two (2) judging sessions for the 'Regatta Ambassador' Quest for which attendance is compulsory:

Saturday (Regatta Day)

Entrants are to meet Judges and 2011 Regatta winner at the John Colvin Memorial Grandstand at 3pm. Entrants should wear smart casual clothes.

- Entrants will be briefed as to their involvement in the Regatta and the judging requirements for 'Regatta Ambassador'
- Entrants will be interviewed on an individual basis by a judging panel.
- Questions will address the criteria as shown on the previous page under 'Judging of the 2012 Regatta Ambassador Quest'

Monday (People's Day)

Entrants are to meet at Waterman's Dock (lower end of Murray Street) at 2.30pm sharp. Entrants are to wear smart summer attire (for example, summer dress and summer hat). Please bring a jacket as it may be cold.

- Entrants will be met by a representative of the Regatta and cruise to the Regatta Ground on board the Police launch while enjoying a light lunch.
- After the cruise, entrants will make their way from the Regatta wharf to the Regatta Pavillion for a light refreshment before final judging.
- Entrants will be introduced to Regatta patrons at 3pm on the Regatta Stage, in front of the Regatta Grandstand, followed by formal presentation of prizes.
- Official photos will be taken following the presentations.

Rules of the Regatta Ambassador Quest

- Entry fee is \$25.00 and is non-refundable.
- Entries must be on the official entry form.
- Entrants in the 'Regatta Ambassador' Quest must be 15 years of age or over.
- If the entrant is under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must give their permission by signing the entry form.
- A photo of the entrant must be submitted with the official entry form.
- The Royal Hobart Regatta Association Inc reserves the right to use any of the entrants' photographs and other material for publicity purposes (photos must therefore not be subject to Copyright or must have the approval of the photographer).
- The Royal Hobart Regatta Association Inc reserves the right to refuse or suspend any entry without entering into correspondence.
